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#### Data:

- 21 Registered Runners, 19 Starters, 16 Finishers
- For 14 of the 16 finishers, this was their first Ultramarathon event.
- One of the finishers, Steve Addison, has yet to run a marathon. His previous longest race was 10.2 miles long. He was the youngest finisher.
- Rich Spady led the first 30 miles of the race, going through the marathon distance in 3.12. Between 30 & 35 miles Mike Nicklin passed him, and at 40 miles was 11 minutes ahead. At 45 miles Rich had made up 4 of those minutes, and caught Mike in the final mile to win by a minute and 11 seconds.
- Ed Anacker, 61, fresh from a successful Western States 100 in June, was the oldest finisher. A study of his split times revealed a pace that varied little from start to finish, a reflection of patience and experience that is worth noting.
- Bobbie Dixon turned in a rather startling 7.21. According to U.S. age-group records, the fastest time by a 35-year old woman is 6.43. However, if Bobbie had been 34 or 36, she would have had a U.S. record as the 34-year record is 8.04 and the 36-year record is 8.16. (The record wouldn't have been official, since Le Grizz isn't certified, but it's still interesting.)
